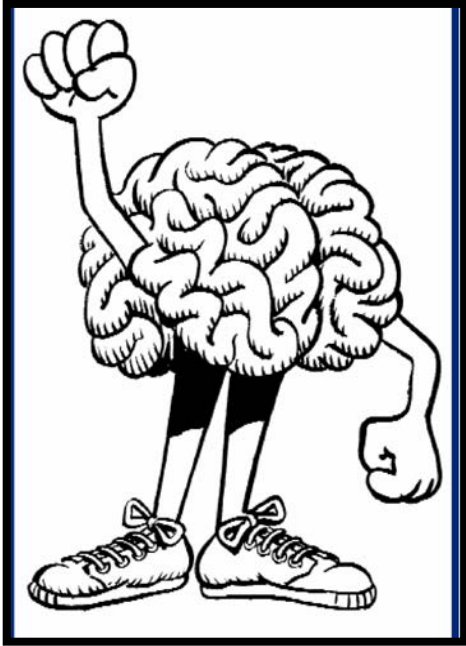


# **Brains Rule! Neuroscience Expo**
