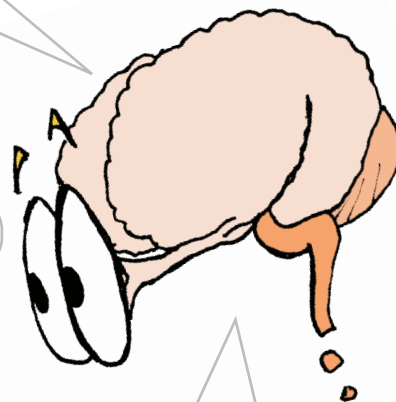
Brian & the Brain in... **Brain Awareness Month!**

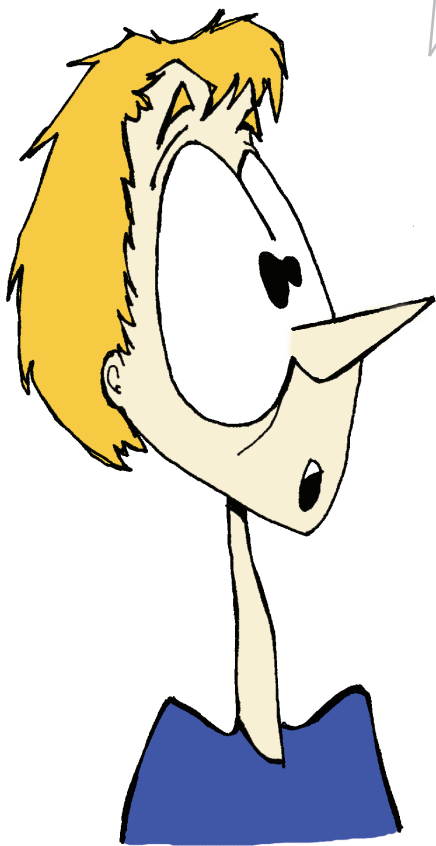
